#### Objective

Hotspots is seeking two experienced Ecologists and two Facilitators to assist with the delivery of the Hotspots Fire Project Training Program within the Namoi Catchment Management Authority region and also within a Local Aboriginal Land Council on the Central Coast. The Training program is delivered through a series of 3 workshops and/or field days over the next eight months.

The Ecologists should have a sound understanding of fire ecology and demonstrated experience delivering information to landholders in workshops and/or as part of group field excursions. Interested Ecologists should live/and or work within a 60 km radius of Gunnedah or Gosford, NSW.

The Facilitators need to have a demonstrated experience engaging with members of the community, facilitating consensus building and conflict resolution in workshop settings. The Facilitators should live/work within NSW and have experience working in the Natural Resource Management Sector and/or with Indigenous groups. It is desirable for the Facilitators to have a working knowledge of fire management and ecology within NSW.
